

Dress Code

- Pants/shorts must be worn at the belt line above the hips, no sagging pants
- Hats/caps cannot be worn inside any buildings and must be worn facing forward at all times
- All attire worn (garments, hats, socks, shoes) is in good taste for the school environment and free of depictions of violence, profanity, drugs or alcohol, racial or off color comments/references, sex or gangs. Bandannas are allowed on declared spirit days only
- Footwear must be worn at all times. For safety purposes, sandals must have a heel strap. No flip flops, slippers, or backless shoes allowed.
- Undergarments are not to be exposed at any time (underwear, boxers, bra, or bra straps)
- Tops must be modest and midriffs covered at all times in ALL activities, even when arms are raised
 - No low cut, halter, tube or strapless tops
 - No loose fitting muscle shirts
 - 1" wide straps are appropriate
- No tight, revealing, or see through clothing
- All skirts, dresses, and shorts may not be shorter than mid-thigh. No shorts shorter than 3" inseam. Mid-thigh is defined as the finger-tip length when a student's arms are down at their side.
 - No cutoffs or pajamas
 - No torn or ripped jeans above the mid-thigh
 - No Spandex shorts

CONSEQUENCES

When students are unsuitably dressed, students will have to call home and have appropriate clothing brought to them. The students will be restricted to the office area until appropriate clothing is brought and the situation is resolved.
